Olympia Breakfast Outing

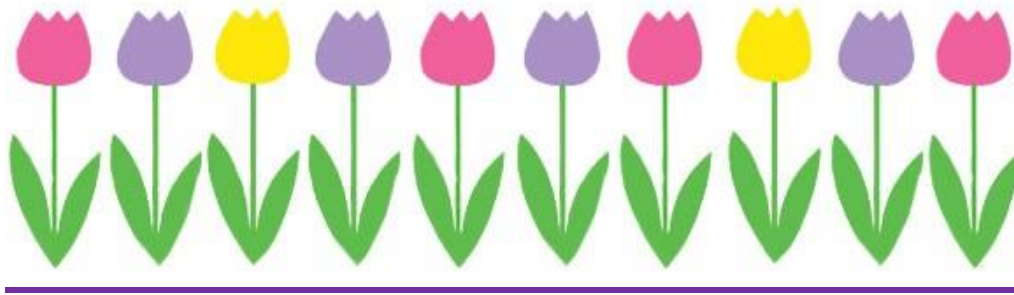

Glamour Day

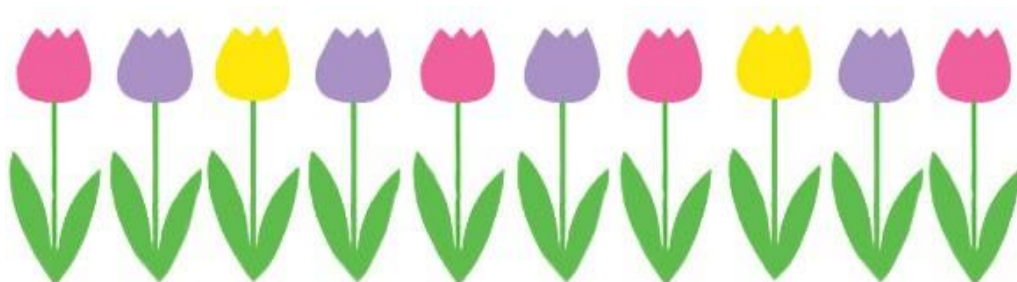
Monday, April 23rd~ 2:00 pm – 4:00PM (Chapel)

We are kicking off our annual Alzheimer's Association Walk Fundraising Campaign. So your support by wearing **purple** today!!

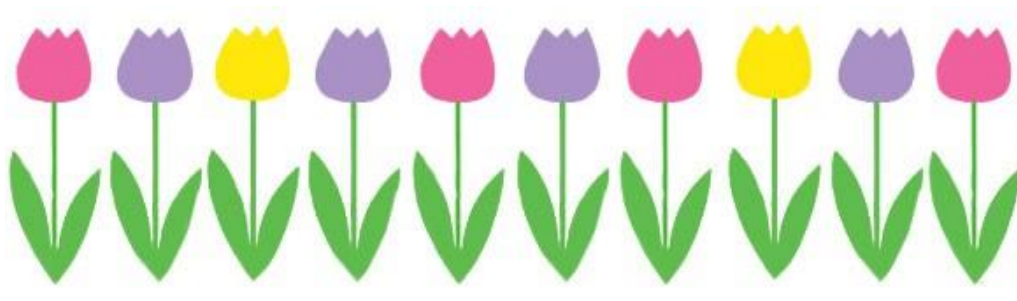
